This workshop engages, stimulates and educates the learner in a way that ensures retention and application of knowledge is maximised. It is fun, engaging, thought provoking and filled with practical knowledge to help improve employee engagement and productivity within your organisation.

The learning objectives for this programme are:

- Look at your leadership employee engagement traits (via an assessment completed in the workshop) to help improve your leadership style to achieve better results
- Complete a 30, 60, 90, 120 day action plan to help participants understand where they need to focus in order to improve employee engagement
- Motivate participants to want to perform to the highest standards
- Become an engaged leader

A short pre-read of The Bee Book is a recommended prerequisite.

Who should attend this workshop?

Leaders and managers who want to make a difference and attain better results; Leaders who wish to get more from their employees; Leaders and managers who care about their employees and want to make their organisation the best place to work; and the employees themselves.

Duration: 2 days
